REGULAR MEETING

The regular meeting of the Bay County Road Commission, Road Department, was called to order at 9:00 a.m., at 2600 E. Beaver Road, by the Chairman, William Schumacher.

Commissioner Shark moved to approve reconstructing the northern commercial access on Linwood Road, also waiving the eastbound decel lane and shortening the eastbound accel lane for said commercial access, for a proposed gas station and convenience store to be located at 11 S. Huron Road in Kawkawlin Township. Motion was adopted on a roll call vote:

Engineer-Manager's Report – Cash Balance, Credit Card Report and MTF Report – City signed the design agreement for State Park Drive – to schedule a Steering Committee meeting for the Killarney/Ricoma Beach project – Fraser Street and Erickson Road right-of-way work is complete – Waiting for EGLE clearance for Seven Mile Rd – Mill and fill project update (Midland, Salzburg and Kiesel) – Shady Shore project update – Midland Road Phase 2 almost complete, Phase 3 starting July 14th – Kaiser Tower Bridge Project starting on July 20th – Beaver Road pre-con was held on Monday, construction to begin August 5th – Beaver Road box culvert update – Countywide paving is complete – Roof of new building is complete – Working on 2027 road and bridge project plan for budget – Rubber chip seal starting in August.

General Superintendent's Report – Chip seal is completed in the East District – Fog sealing the rest of this week – West District chip seal to begin July 20th – Beaver Road box culvert – crack sealing – DuraPatching – long arm mowing – primary road mowing – performing shoulder maintenance – grading for brine.

Motion was adopted on a roll call vote:

J. and M. Enfield – Provided further information on presented easement petition.

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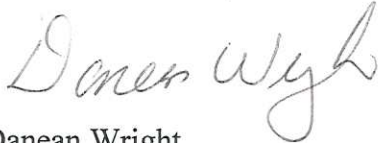
