REGULAR MEETING

The regular meeting of the Bay County Road Commission, Road Department, was called to order at 9:00 a.m., at 2600 E. Beaver Road, by the Chairman, William Schumacher.

Commissioner Schumacher moved to approve Agreement #214699, with Williams Township for removal, installation, and construction oversight of a sidewalk along the north side of Midland Road, between 11 Mile and Garfield Road. Project is estimated at \$86,914.70. Total Township Share is \$86,914.70. The Chairman and Clerk are authorized to sign for the Board. Motion was adopted on a roll call vote:

Commissioner Shark moved to approve Agreement #213917, with Kawkawlin Township for HMA paving on North Boutell Road. Project is estimated at \$105,847.00. Building Better Local Roads is \$30,000.00.
