REGULAR MEETING

The regular meeting of the Bay County Road Commission, Road Department, was called to order at 9:00 a.m., at 2600 E. Beaver Road, by the Chairman, William Schumacher.

T. Spencer – Responding to comment on 8 Mile Rd, Monitor willing to help with funding.


G. Augustyniak – Resident questioning/requesting No Parking signs on Oak Rd.
